

## CIHI Data Dictionary Terms of Use

The CIHI Data Dictionary (the “Data Dictionary”) is supplied to you by the Canadian Institute for Health Information (“CIHI”) for your use in return for your agreement to the following terms (the “Agreement”). If you use or install the Data Dictionary, you will be deemed to have read, understood, and accepted the Agreement. If you do not agree with this Agreement, please do not use or install the Data Dictionary.

- CIHI grants to you a non-exclusive, non-transferable and non-assignable license to use and reproduce the Data Dictionary solely for non-commercial purposes relating to the collection and manipulation of health information. This licence cannot and does not extend to any material in the Data Dictionary that is identified as being attributable to a third party. For authorisation to reproduce such material please contact the third party concerned.
- If you use or reproduce all or a portion of the Data Dictionary you agree to acknowledge and mention CIHI as the source of the Data Dictionary.
- Should you wish to make any commercial use of the Data Dictionary, please contact CIHI so that CIHI may consider the request, and if accepted by CIHI, make the necessary arrangements for the appropriate form of license.
- The intellectual property rights in the Data Dictionary belong to CIHI and its licensors. You do not obtain title to or ownership of the Data Dictionary or any other property rights except for the license granted by this Agreement.
- You may not and, may not permit others to use an outdated version of the Data Dictionary. You are responsible for ensuring that you are using the most current version of the Data Dictionary.
- The Data Dictionary is licensed to you on an “AS IS” basis without any warranty of any nature. In no event shall CIHI be liable to you for any loss or damage resulting from, or in connection with, your use of the Data Dictionary.
- CIHI may immediately terminate this Agreement if you breach any of the terms and conditions contained in this Agreement or at any time on written notice to you. In the event that this license is terminated for any reason, you shall immediately cease all use of the Data Dictionary, and promptly return or destroy all whole and partial copies, including any updates.
- This Agreement contains the entire agreement between you and CIHI with respect to the Data Dictionary and may not be modified, except by written agreement of the parties. It supersedes all prior agreements, negotiations, representations, and proposals, written or oral, relating to the licensing of the Data Dictionary. This Agreement is governed by and will be construed in accordance with the laws of the Province of Ontario. The parties to this Agreement hereby irrevocably and unconditionally attorn to jurisdiction of the courts of the Province of Ontario located in Ottawa, Ontario, Canada. If any part of this Agreement is held to be invalid or otherwise unenforceable, the provision shall no longer form part of this Agreement. No failure or delay by either party in exercising any right, power or privilege hereunder shall operate as a waiver of such right, power or privilege. The parties do not intend that any agency or partnership

relationship be created between them by this Agreement. Each party shall execute and deliver all such further documents and instruments and do all acts and things as the other party may reasonably require to carry out the full intent and meaning of this Agreement. This Agreement may not be assigned or transferred (through a change of control or otherwise) by you without CIHI's prior written consent and shall enure to the benefit of and be binding on the parties, their respective successors and permitted assigns. Provisions that, by their nature, should remain in effect beyond the termination of this License shall survive, including but not limited to those concerning intellectual property rights ownership and the preceding general terms.
