About the survey

The 2013 Commonwealth Fund International Health Policy Survey of the General Public includes a random sample of the general public in 11 countries: Australia, Canada, France, Germany, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Sweden, Switzerland, United Kingdom and United States. Expanded sampling in Canada, allowed for interprovincial comparison among 10 provinces.

The survey was conducted via landline and mobile telephone in each country with a nationally representative sample of respondents, age 18 and older. The survey was conducted between March and June 2013. A complete list of all survey questions is available at www.commonwealthfund.org.

Weighting

Data from each country were weighted to ensure the final sample was representative of the adult population. The weighting procedure accounted for the sample design and probability of selection, as well as systematic non-response across known population parameters. The survey data for Canada were weighted by province, age-by-gender, educational attainment, knowledge of official language, and phone status (cell phone only or not) to reflect the demographic composition. Quebec, Ontario, Alberta and all-other-provinces data were weighted separately, so that each of these subsamples (Quebec; Ontario, Alberta, all-other-provinces combined) accurately represented the corresponding population. Population parameters (with the exception of phone status) were derived from the Canada 2006 Census. Phone status was derived from the 2012 Residential Telephone Service Survey (RTSS), for Canada as a whole and for Quebec, Ontario, and Alberta in particular. For each geographic unit, the cell-phone only percentage indicated in the data was increased by 10% to account for the likely increase over the time elapsed since data collection. In the final weighting step, the weights were decreased and or increased as necessary so that the share of each province reflected the share of that province among Canadian adults. Tables presented in this supplement show weighted results.

Margin of Error of Estimates

The table below reports the weight-adjusted margins-of-error for countries and targeted regions. The maximum margins of error reported below apply to estimates of 50%; for smaller or larger estimates, the margin of sampling error will be smaller. Sampling error is only one type of error that could affect survey outcomes. Margin of error estimates are corrected for design effects caused by the sampling methods used in different countries and the weighting needed to adjust for that.
